

HOURS AND TERM OF APPOINTMENT	Hours are flexible so long as meetings in online platforms (mostly evenings, EST) can be attended. Interns may work in any or all quarters, Spring, Summer and Fall for the minimum (three months). Longer commitment periods engage interns in larger projects.
